COVID & FLU VACCINES 2024

This season so far, we have vaccinated 1523 patients against COVID and 1579 patients against Flu.

Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) Vaccines

The RSV vaccine is recommended if:

- you're pregnant (from 28 weeks of pregnancy) this will help protect your baby for the first few months after they're born
- you're aged 75 to 79

The vaccine helps reduce the risk of RSV causing serious problems such as pneumonia and bronchiolitis.

We are inviting patients in age order; you will be called in to you have your vaccine in due course.
